Energy

- Lights and equipment are switched off when not in use.
- Utilising the natural light of the office so not all lights need to be used.
- Purchase electricity from providers who can guarantee that it comes from renewable or low carbon sources.

Waste and Recycling

- Printing only when necessary.
- Reusing scrap paper where possible.
- Recycling paper, card, plastics, and cans via the council recycling scheme.
- Avoiding using single use plastic where possible.
- Removal of desk bins, keeping only those in the kitchen areas to encourage staff to recycle items in the correct bins rather than throw everything in their desk bin.
- All recycling is washed to ensure no contamination.
- Food waste is deposited in a composter. The compost will then be used to grow plants or vegetables in the office courtyard area.

Travel

- Company policy states that our company cars are hybrid.
- Our office is located near the railway station to encourage the use of public transport.
- Monthly carpooling sessions.
- Use collaborative technologies such as video conferencing or teleconferencing wherever possible to reduce business travel.

Procurement

- Where suitable we select products made from recycled materials
- When buying or replacing electronic equipment, we choose energy efficient equipment.
- We seek to work with local suppliers and support the local economy whenever possible.

Water Management

- Consider water usage when washing up by washing multiple items together and not leaving the tap running.
